His published work has appeared, among others, in the Journal of Institutional Economics, Geoforum, International Journal of the Commons, World Political Science Review, Revue Francaise d'Administration Publique, and Society and Economy. He has also done extensive work in applied policy analysis and consultancy in the fields of employment policy, higher education and entrepreneurial policy at Hetfa Research, a private institute, including serving as a chief evaluator of Hungary's grant programmes co-financed by the European Union between 2007-2013. Currently, he is completing a research project on the institutional infrastructure of Hungary's entrepreneurial economy.
